# Earscreen<sup>™</sup> - early detection of hearing impairment in newborns and infants

This year, Cordlife will be continuing on their mission towards preventive paediatric healthcare and screening through an innovative new service called Earscreen<sup>™</sup>. The service renders support for the early detection of hearing loss in infants, which has been found to be pertinent in our generation. According to a report by NUSH, <u>three out of every 1,000 babies born in Singapore</u> have significant hearing loss despite their parents having normal hearing. If such conditions go untreated, the child may suffer delays in their speech, language, intellectual, social and emotional development.

This new service allows parents and healthcare providers to detect hearing loss in infants as early as 6 months old, ensuring that necessary treatment and interventions can be provided in a timely manner. This new initiative enables parents to access the latest technology in medical screening for their children so they receive the highest quality care available. Cordlife is passionate about providing families with the healthcare and support they need, and this significant step is a milestone in their mission to help the community in every way they can.

Deepening their partnership for the 3rd consecutive year, Cordlife has been actively organizing donation drives for Canossaville. This is an ongoing initiative that has since benefitted 300 children and their families.

"We are grateful to partners like Cordlife for their sustainable support over the years.
